1914-1985

DAYTON, Ohio, September 5, 1985 -- John Thompson, assistant professor of philosophy at the University of Dayton from 1967 until his retirement last April, died after a short illness on Tuesday, September 3. He was 71.

At the University of Dayton, Thompson taught business ethics and medieval philosophy courses. He was a dedicated professor and well-liked by students and fellow faculty members.

In the Dayton community, Thompson was a member of the Kiwanis Club and an organist at St. Charles Catholic Church. Thompson was a native of Montreal, Canada.

There will be no viewing, but a Memorial Mass will be held 10:30 a.m. Saturday at St. Charles Catholic Church. Instead of flowers the family has requested donations be made to the American Heart Foundation.
