**LYRICS TO BE SIGNED AND SUNG
AT UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON CONCERT**

DAYTON, Ohio, October 14, 1986—"Hands on Harmony," a group of University of Dayton students, will bring music to the deaf by performing song lyrics in sign language during a free concert on Sunday, October 19, at 3 p.m. in UD's Immaculate Conception Chapel. Under the direction of Phillip Magnuson, the group will join with the University Chamber Orchestra and the University Chamber Choir in a performance of Schubert's "Ave Maria."

Other selections to be played by the orchestra include the "Corelli Concerto Grosso" and "Adagio for Strings" by Samuel Barber. The Schubert "Mass in G" will be performed with the University Chamber Choir. The choir, directed by James Dill, will also perform "Ave Verum Corpus" by William Byrd, "Exultate Deo" by Scarlatti, and "Awake the Trumpets Lofty Sound" by Handel.
