**CHILDREN'S POETRY WORKSHOPS  
HELD AT UD**

**DAYTON, Ohio, October 21, 1986**—The University of Dayton will host a series of workshops entitled "Poetry: Music with Words and Space," Monday, November 3, in the Kennedy Union West Ballroom. Arnold Adoff, a well-known author, poet, and anthologist, will be giving three presentations specifically for teachers and education students. The workshops are free and open to the public.

The first workshop, "Poetry Reading for Children," will be held from 9:30 to 10:30 a.m. and will demonstrate methods of reading and interpreting poetry. The next workshop from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. is called "Poetry in the Classroom," and it will show participants how to integrate poetry into their lessons. "Creativity and Poetry Writing" is the title of the final session from 2 to 4 p.m. It is designed to help teachers learn how to release the creative energy trapped in both their students and themselves.
