HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS OFFERED HEAD START AT UD

DAYTON, Ohio, March 27, 1987--The University of Dayton invites qualified high school juniors to get a head start on college this summer.

Summer Advancement '87 permits 50 students to take a college course free of charge and earn credits that can be applied toward any academic major. Participants enroll in regular college courses taught by University of Dayton professors. Classes begin June 18 and continue through July 30.

Summer Advancement students pay only textbook costs, transportation charges, personal expenses, and any laboratory or materials fees. Credits may be applied toward a UD degree at no charge by participants who enroll in the University of Dayton's fall 1988 class. The normal \$15 application fee will also be waived for any Summer Advancement participant who applies for UD's fall 1988 class.

Students who wish to transfer Summer Advancement credits to another university will be assessed this summer's tuition rate at the time the transfer is requested.

It is recommended that applicants rank in the top 20 percent of their class and maintain a B (3.0) grade point average. To apply, students must complete an application form and obtain the recommendation of their guidance counselor. Application deadline for the program is Friday, May 15.
