UD PROFESSOR RECEIVES FULBRIGHT
GRANT TO LECTURE IN WEST AFRICA

DAYTON, Ohio, June 19, 1987--Physics, Liberia, and the University of Dayton are all coming together thanks to the Fulbright exchange program. Dr. Rex L. Berney of UD's Physics Department has been awarded a Fulbright grant to lecture and establish an electronics laboratory at the University of Liberia in Monrovia.

Dr. Berney is one of approximately 2,500 U.S. grant recipients being sent abroad for the 1987-88 academic year under the Fulbright exchange program. The program is designed "to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the people of other countries." Individuals are selected on the basis of academic and professional qualifications plus their ability and willingness to share ideas and experiences with people of diverse cultures.

Dr. Berney has been an associate professor of physics at UD for nine years. He is a member of the American Association of Physics Teachers' national committee on Computers in Physics Education. His appointment in Liberia begins July 1.
