NEGRO ENSEMBLE COMPANY PRESENTS THEATRE WORKSHOP AT UD

DAYTON, Ohio, October 29, 1987--The Negro Ensemble Company will present a general theatre workshop Monday, November 9, at 4 p.m. in the Music-Theatre Building on the UD campus. The workshop is free and open to the Dayton community.

The program will include a slide show on the history of the company, followed by an open question-and-answer session.

The Negro Ensemble Company will be in Dayton to present a production of Trevor Rhone's spicy West Indian comedy Two Can Play Monday, November 9, at 8 p.m. in Kennedy Union Boll Theatre as part of the University of Dayton Arts Series.

The Negro Ensemble Company is a not-for-profit corporation that is partially funded by the National Endowment for the Arts and the New York State Council on the Arts. The UD appearance of the Negro Ensemble Company is supported in part by Arts Midwest and the Ohio Arts Council and co-sponsored by UD's Office for Minority Student Affairs.
