Black History Month began as an effort to acknowledge the historical events and contributions made by blacks in the molding of America. Black historian Carter G. Woodson and the American Society for Studies of Negro History and Life first designated the week of February 15 as Negro History Week in 1926. The week eventually expanded into what is now Black History Month. This year's national theme is "The Constitutional Status of Afro Americans into the 21st Century."
