### UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON OFFERS LONDON STUDY TOUR FOR ADULTS

DAYTON, Ohio, February 22, 1988--The University of Dayton's Center for International Education (CIE) offers adults the opportunity to combine the pleasures of travel with the rewards of learning.

CIE is sponsoring "London: A Visual Experience," a two-week study tour of art, design and creative photography in London from June 18 - July 3.

Two University of Dayton faculty members, Fred Niles and Sean Wilkinson, will conduct informal classes and field trips during the program. No prior educational or practical experience is required to participate; the only prerequisites are a valid passport and an interest in the subjects offered.

The cost of the program is \$2,295 per person, which includes round-trip airfare between Dayton and London, 14 days double-occupancy lodging at the Royal National Hotel (located near Russell Square in the Bloomsbury district of London), continental breakfast and two one-day excursions.

Academic credit is available at extra cost. Departures and returns from cities other than Dayton can be arranged through CIE at adjusted cost, as can single-occupancy lodging.
