JESSE JACKSON TO APPEAR AT UD FIELDHOUSE

The Rev. Jesse Jackson, Democratic candidate for president in the May 3 Ohio primary, will appear at a campaign rally at the University of Dayton Fieldhouse on Saturday, April 30. The rally begins at 1 p.m. with gospel groups and special performances by young adults. Jackson will then speak at 3 p.m. Admission to the Fieldhouse will be free of charge. A loudspeaker system will be utilized in the event of an overflow crowd.

SECRETARY OF COMMERCE TO BE HONORED IN DAYTON

William Verity, United States Secretary of Commerce, will be honored at a luncheon on Friday, April 29, sponsored by the University of Dayton School of Business Administration and the Wright State University College of Business and Administration.

The luncheon will be held at the Mandalay Banquet Center, 2700 E. River Road, from noon to 2 p.m. Verity's address will concern the Commerce Department's "Export Now" program, which is designed to encourage businesses to promote exports. A press conference will be held following the luncheon. Verity will make a short statement on the "Export Now" program and then take questions from the media.

Verity is the 27th U.S. Secretary of Commerce. In 1940, he joined Armco, Inc., a Middletown company, and was elected president and chief executive officer in 1965. From 1971 to 1982, Verity served as chairman of the board. In 1984, he was made co-chairman of the U.S.-U.S.S.R. Trade and Economic Council, a private organization of business executives which promotes increased trade between the two world powers.

A Yale graduate and Navy veteran, he received an honorary doctorate in 1973 from the University of Dayton, and served on the Board of Trustees from 1974 to 1977. He has been an honorary trustee of the University since May 1981.
