SPORT PSYCHOLOGY EXPERT TO SPEAK AT UD ARENA

DAYTON, Ohio, September 16, 1988--William P. Morgan, an authority in sport psychology research, will speak at the University of Dayton Arena Associates Lounge on Friday, September 30 from 3 to 4 p.m. The event is free and open to the public.

Morgan's presentation, "Research and Trends in Sport Psychology," is part of the second annual "Distinguished Persons in Physical Education Series," sponsored by the Department of Physical and Health Education.

A professor and director of the Sport Psychology Laboratory at the University of Wisconsin at Madison, Morgan is a member of the U.S. Olympic Committee and Sport Psychology Committee, and a consultant for the Elite Distance Runners Project at the Olympic training center.

He researches personality, perception, motivation and psychopathology with athletes in running, rowing, swimming and wrestling. Sport psychology research and its meaning and application for the physical educator and coach will be discussed.
