'FRONTIERS IN TELECOMMUNICATIONS' SEMINAR SLATED AT UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON

DAYTON, Ohio, October 14, 1988--The second seminar in the "Frontiers in Telecommunications" series will be held at the University of Dayton on Tuesday, Oct. 25, beginning at 7:30 a.m. The seminar, titled "Telecommunications from the Industry's Standpoint," will be held in the UD Arena lounge.

"This series of seminars offers basic information about telecommunications," said Sister Angela Ann Zukowski, M.H.S.H., director of the Center for Religious Telecommunications at UD. "It was designed to raise the consciousness of Dayton business and government officials of the importance of telecommunications in economic and educational growth and development."

The seminar will begin at 7:30 a.m. with a continental breakfast, followed at 8 a.m. by a presentation from John Malone, UD graduate and president of Eastern Management Group in Parsippany, N.J. He will address planning for implementation of a telecommunications system for effective business and operation of a city. Participants will then have the opportunity to view telecommunications exhibits at the arena.

The series is open to the public. Registration fee for the remaining five seminars is \$150, and fee for a single seminar is \$50. For registration information, call the Miami Valley Research and Planning Commission at 223-6323. Registration is due by Oct. 24.

"Frontiers in Telecommunications" was designed by the City of Dayton Advanced Telecommunications Task Force. The third seminar will be held Nov. 16 at the Dayton Convention Center.
