JACK HANNA BRINGING ZOO ANIMALS TO UD

DAYTON, Ohio, November 9, 1988--Jack Hanna, director of the Columbus Zoo, will bring several species of zoo animals to an appearance at the University of Dayton on Tuesday, Nov. 15 from 7:30 to 9 p.m. His presentation, which is free and open to the public, will be held in the Kennedy Union Boll Theatre on campus.

Hanna will bring a baby tiger, a serval (wild African cat), two baby orangutans, a parrot and "assorted surprises" for the program. Included in the program will be excerpts from his appearances on "Good Morning America" and "Late Night with David Letterman," as well as a slide show of Africa. Hanna's next appearance on the Letterman program will be on Dec. 1.

Cameras are welcome at the program, and photos may be taken of Hanna and the animals. Hanna does not allow members of the audience to pose for photos with the animals.
