FINANCIAL AID SEMINAR SLATED AT UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON

DAYTON, Ohio, January 12, 1989--The University of Dayton will hold a Financial Aid Seminar on Wednesday, Jan. 18 from 7 to 9 p.m. at the UD Arena Associates Lounge. The seminar is designed to assist families with the completion of financial aid forms for the 1989-90 school year.

The seminar is free and plenty of parking will be available. No reservations are necessary. Information will deal with general financial aid matters, and will be applicable for all universities and colleges.

"The financial aid process is a very confusing one for families," said Joyce Wilkins, director of financial aid at UD. "We offer these seminars as a community service to try to uncomplicate the process. We give a general overview of what financial aid is, how families can apply and how colleges respond." Wilkins noted that families are asked to examine a financial aid form, available from high school guidance offices, and then bring their questions and the form to the seminar.

Approximately 85 percent of UD's students receive some form of financial aid. The average amount awarded is \$4,224. Funds from UD, federal and state programs, private sources, scholarships, grants, loans and work opportunities have provided \$25 million in financial aid for UD students during the current academic year.
