HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS, SENIORS INVITED TO UD'S 'CAREERS UNLIMITED'

DAYTON, Ohio, February 1, 1989--In conjunction with Black History Month, the University of Dayton will sponsor "Careers Unlimited" on Saturday, Feb. 11 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. in the Kennedy Union Ballroom on campus. The day-long program, designed for high school juniors and seniors as well as UD students, will allow the students to meet and learn about careers from professionals in the Dayton community.

Reservations are due Feb. 9 and can be made by calling (513) 229-3634. The cost is \$5 for non-UD students.

Keynote speaker for "Careers Unlimited" will be Wilmer C. Ames Jr., publisher of "Emerge" magazine, a publication aimed at young black professionals that will be launched in September. Ames, a former reporter for "Sports Illustrated," said his presentation will stress "that it's possible to be a black entrepreneur." Ames will speak at 12:45 p.m.

Registration will be conducted from 9 to 9:30 a.m. Workshop sessions will be held from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. and will focus on resume writing, job searching techniques, interviewing skills and stress management. Luncheon roundtable sessions with professionals from the community will provide an opportunity for informal discussion. A job fair will be held from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. with representatives from AT&T, Ford Motor Co., GM, B.F. Goodrich, State Farm Insurance, Kroger, Elder Beerman and the Dayton Police Academy, among others.
