JAZZ GROUPS TO PERFORM AT UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON

DAYTON, Ohio, February 8, 1989--Jazz will take center stage at the University of Dayton on Wednesday, Feb. 15 when the UD Jazz Ensemble and Jazz Combos perform at 8 p.m. in Boll Theatre in Kennedy Union on campus. Admission is free and open to the public.

"The students are playing very well," said David Hoffman, director of jazz studies at UD and conductor of the Jazz Ensemble. "This will be one of our better performances."

Featured soloists will be senior Tim Grayson on tenor saxophone, freshman Matt Clancy on alto saxophone and junior Tim Wourms on drums. A total of 18 students perform in the ensemble, and 15 students are involved in performing with one of the several combos at UD. The Jazz Combos are directed by Robert Bowen.
