### INTERFAITH DIALOGUE TO BE PRESENTED AT UD

DAYTON, Ohio, April 25, 1989--"Christian-Jewish Dialogue: The Third Millenium," an interfaith education institute, will be presented at 3 p.m. on Sunday, May 7 at the University of Dayton. The program will be held in O'Leary Auditorium in Miriam Hall on campus.

Rabbi Jack Riemer and the Rev. John T. Pawlikowski will be the featured speakers. They will focus on expectations and hopes for the continuation of Christian-Jewish dialogue as the next century approaches. A question-and-answer session will follow the program.

Riemer is the spiritual leader of Beth David Congregation in Miami, Fla. He served for many years as the rabbi of Congregation Beth Abraham in Dayton and was a founding member of the Jewish-Christian Dialogue in Dayton. He was formerly an adjunct professor at UD, teaching modern Jewish thought. Riemer is the editor of "New Prayers for the High Holidays" used in hundreds of congregations.

Pawlikowski is currently the professor of social ethics at the Catholic Theological Union. He is the author of eight books and is consulting editor of "Journal of Holocaust and Genocide Studies." He is a founding member of the National Interreligious Task Force on Soviet Jewry and serves on the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Council.
