**UD PHOTO VIDEOCONFERENCE  
TO FEATURE JAY MAISEL**

DAYTON, Ohio, Sept. 28, 1989--Professional and serious amateur photographers will have a chance to question Jay Maisel on his techniques and philosophy of photography when the University of Dayton presents a videoconference on Thursday, Oct. 5 at 7 p.m. The videoconference, to be held in Miriam Hall Room 43 on campus, is free and open to the public.

"Maisel is a well-known commercial photographer, based in New York, who works primarily in color photography," said Jack Teemer, associate professor of photography at UD. "This session should be of interest to the entire photographic community in the Dayton area."

Approximately four sessions of the Kodak Videoconference Series, "Techniques of the Masters," will be presented at UD this year. Each session will feature previously filmed segments about the photographer and his or her work, and additional segments will allow photographers around the nation to call and ask questions of the artist. Both commercial and fine artists will be featured in the series.
