DAYTON, Ohio, Oct. 17, 1989--Faith in Action, an interfaith fellowship of physically disabled adults, will meet on Sunday, Nov. 5 from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. at South Park United Methodist Church, Brown Street and Stonemill Road. The devotional service during the meeting will be a memorial for deceased members of the group.

Ron Gordon, a member of the Seventh-day Adventist Church clergy and chaplain at Kettering Medical Center, will present a program on "Dealing with Loss." Gordon leads a course in grief recovery at the medical center. The program will also include a business meeting and social period.

Participants are asked to bring one or more toilet items to be donated to St. Vincent's Hotel for the Homeless and canned goods or non-perishable items for the Emergency Resource Bank.
