**'CHILLS FOR CHARITY'
RETURNS TO UD CAMPUS**

DAYTON, Ohio, Oct. 19, 1989--"Chills for Charity...A Nightmare at Stuart Hall II," a Halloween party and haunted house at Stuart Residence Hall at the University of Dayton, will be held on Saturday, Oct. 28 from 7 p.m. to midnight. Proceeds from this second annual event will benefit Children's Medical Center.

"Chills for Charity" is open to the public. Admission will be \$2.

"Visitors will be taken to the top floor of the east wing, and then they'll work their way down to the basement, which will be converted into a chamber of horrors," said Steve Shute, president of the Stuart Residence Hall Council. Outside festivities will include a deejay, food and beverages, and prizes will be awarded for the best costumes.

Last year's event raised \$350 for Children's Medical Center. Proceeds will be donated to the medical center through the Children's Miracle Network Telethon.
