**FIVE NEW MUSIC TALENT AWARDS
ESTABLISHED AT UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON**

DAYTON, Ohio, Nov. 16, 1989--Five new scholarships have been established in the University of Dayton's music division.

Music talent awards of \$3,000, renewable for four years, will be given to five 1990-91 freshmen, based on competitive auditions for music faculty. Students must also meet general entrance requirements for the University.

"With these scholarships, deserving and talented students will be able to develop their potential while enhancing the quality of the undergraduate music program," said Linda J. Snyder, associate professor of voice and head of the music division at UD. "We're very excited to be able to award these scholarships for incoming freshmen, and we encourage interested music students to audition."

Audition dates for 1990-91 admission and scholarship consideration are Dec. 2, 1989, and Jan. 6, Feb. 10 and March 17, 1990. Arrangements should be made by calling the UD music division at (513) 229-3936.
