**TOM PETTY AND THE HEARTBREAKERS TO BRING
'MORE STRANGE BEHAVIOR' TO UD ARENA**

DAYTON, Ohio, January 16, 1990--Tickets are now on sale for the "More Strange Behavior" performance by Tom Petty and the Heartbreakers at the University of Dayton Arena on Saturday, Feb. 10 at 8 p.m.

Tickets for the show, with opening act Lenny Kravitz, are \$17.50 and are available at the UD Arena box office and local Ticketron outlets.

Kicking off Jan. 26 in Tampa, Fla., the two-month "More Strange Behavior" tour will include 22 dates in cities around the nation. The tour follows the blockbuster success of Petty's critically acclaimed debut solo album, Full Moon Fever. A fourth single from the album, "A Face In The Crowd," will be released in late January to follow the success of three other singles from the album--"I Won't Back Down," "Runnin' Down A Dream" and "Free Fallin'."

Although Full Moon Fever was developed and completed with limited input from the Heartbreakers, Petty says a break-up of the band is not in the offing. "There wouldn't be any point in going solo, because you can't put together a band like the Heartbreakers," he said. "We'll always stay together, I think, as long as we're getting better and getting something out of it."
