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**FAITH IN ACTION FELLOWSHIP  
TO DISCUSS BUILDING SELF-ESTEEM**

DAYTON, Ohio, January 26, 1990--Faith in Action, an interfaith fellowship of physically disabled adults, will meet on Sunday, Feb. 4 from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. at South Park United Methodist Church, 140 Stonemill Road.

Featured speakers on "Building Self-Esteem" will be Ryan Hornaday, a member of the group, and Cathy Schneider of the University of Dayton's Office for Ministry and Religious Education Services (MORES) Ministry with Handicapped People.

"People with disabilities are often unaware of their own abilities due to protected childhoods or societal prejudices," said Schneider. "We want to point out the strengths and talents of our own members."

In addition to the speakers, the meeting will feature a devotional, small discussion groups, a short business meeting and refreshments of Valentine's Day cake and beverages. Members are asked to bring one or more small toilet items to be donated to St. Vincent's Hotel for the Homeless.
