UD PLANS SUNDAY AFTERNOON OF BEAUTIFUL MUSIC IN 'CAFE VIENNA'

DAYTON, Ohio -- The simple pleasures of beautiful music on a Sunday afternoon will celebrate the spirit of Viennese cafes when the University of Dayton presents "Cafe Vienna: An Afternoon of Viennese Music."

UD's University Chorale, University Orchestra and Chamber Singers will perform at 3 p.m. Sunday, April 14, in the Kennedy Union Ballroom on campus. Audience members will be seated in a cabaret setting and a cash bar will be available. Admission is free and open to the public.

Pieces by Johann Strauss, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, Joseph Haydn and Johannes Brahms will be featured, and a tribute to Leonard Bernstein will include selections from "Candide" and "West Side Story." Elena Letnanova, associate professor of music at UD, will perform Mozart's "Piano Concerto in C."

UD's University Orchestra is under the direction of Phillip Magnuson, associate professor of music, and the University Chorale and Chamber Singers are under the direction of Robert McMillan, UD music instructor.
