**VIKTOR POLONSKY, UD ARTIST-IN-RESIDENCE,
TO PERFORM RECITAL ON CAMPUS**

DAYTON, Ohio -- Pianist Viktor Polonsky, visiting artist-in-residence at the University of Dayton, will perform at 8 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 15 in the Kennedy Union Ball Theatre. Polonsky will perform works by Johannes Brahms and Sergei Prokofiev. The performance is free and open to the public.

Polonsky, a native of Russia, immigrated to Dayton in May 1990. He graduated summa cum laude from the Secondary School of Music and the Conservatory of Music in Kishinev, and he received a doctor of musical arts degree from the Academy of Music in Vladivostok.

Polonsky has been accepted as a concert pianist for inclusion in the Ohio Artists on Tour directory. He has accompanied the Dayton Ballet and has given several concerts since coming to Ohio.
