UD ART EXHIBIT FEATURES CATHOLIC ARTISTS OF THE 1990S

DAYTON, Ohio -- "Faces of Our Lady," an art exhibit featuring Catholic artists of the 1990s, will continue through Oct. 31 in the lobby of the Marian Library at the University of Dayton.

Admission is free and open to the public. The Marian Library is located on the seventh floor of Roesch Library on campus.

The exhibit features the works of 19 members of Catholic Artists of the 90s, a group of more than 200 ecumenical artists throughout the United States. With the focus of the exhibit on Mary, the works range from the fluid qualities of oil and charcoal to the solidity of bronze and clay. Profound serenity, grace and strength are expressed, and the pieces reflect the unifying thread of humans expressing their faith through art.

UD's Marian Library, the world's largest and most comprehensive collection of printed materials on Mary, was established in 1943. It now holds more than 78,000 books and pamphlets in 50 languages, ranging from the 15th century to the present, as well as a collection of statues from around the world.
