### **UD ART SERIES FEATURES THE MAIR-DAVIS DUO**

DAYTON, Ohio -- Five hundred years after Christopher Columbus' voyage, the Spanish and New World music of his time will be recreated by the Mair-Davis Duo when they appear as part of the University of Dayton's 1991-92 Arts Series at 8 p.m., Friday, Nov. 15, in UD's Boll Theatre. Tickets for the performance are \$10.

The duo is composed of Marilynn Mair on mandolin and Mark Davis, her husband, on guitar. Their repertoire includes five centuries of music that spans four continents.

Mair and Davis are the founders of the American Mandolin and Guitar Summer School of Providence, R.I. They have toured across the United States and Europe, and regularly appear at Lincoln Center. They have released a number of recordings since 1980.
