NOVELIST AUSTIN WRIGHT TO SPEAK AT UD

DAYTON, Ohio -- Austin Wright, novelist and English professor at the University of Cincinnati, will read from several of his works, including an unpublished novel, at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 12, in the Kennedy Union West Ballroom at the University of Dayton.

Wright will accept questions from the audience, and a reception will follow the readings. Admission is free and open to the public.

While on campus, Wright will meet with UD faculty and students as well as conduct a class on "Reading, Writing and Criticism" for English students.

His novels include The Morley Mythology, First Persons and Camden's Eyes. He has also written Recalcitrance, Faulkner and the Professors: A Critical Fiction, The Formal Principle in the Novel, The Art of the Short Story: An Introductory Anthology and The American Short Story in the Twenties. He is the Charles Phelps Taft professor of English at UC where he teaches criticism and theory, American fiction and creative writing.
