'BOOKS AND BROADSIDES' EXHIBIT TO BE FEATURED AT UD'S RIKE GALLERY

DAYTON, Ohio -- Books and graphics by two Milwaukee designers will be on display at the University of Dayton's Rike Gallery Thursday, March 5, through Monday, March 23. The exhibit is free and open to the public.

The exhibit, "Books and Broadsides: The Art and Craft of Graphic Design," features the work of Richard Zauft and Jim Escalante, both from Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

"I am most interested in exploring the artistic possibilities of using graphic design with the fine art disciplines of drawing, printmaking and photography," said Zauft. "The work in this show combines a variety of printing processes ranging from the very old to the newest technologies.

"The book as an art form is a wonderful medium to work in," he said. "It presents a unique design challenge: to design for both the two-dimensional page and for the three-dimensional sculpture of the book form."

Hours at the Rike Gallery are 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and noon to 4 p.m. Saturday.
