UD THEATRE TO PRESENT MUSICAL MURDER MYSTERY 'SOMETHING'S AFOOT'

DAYTON, OHIO -- "Whodunit?" is the main question as seven weekend guests and three servants of the late Lord Rancour are killed off one by one in an island mansion during a rain storm. The plot unfolds in the musical mystery, "Something's Afoot," which will be presented at the University of Dayton March 26-28 and April 2-4.

Book, music and lyrics are by James McDonald, David Vos and Robert Gerlach.

"This is a rollicking British musical mystery which takes off on Agatha Christie's murder mysteries," said Larry Selka, director of the production and assistant professor of theatre at UD.

Junior Rachel Sacksteder will portray Miss Tweed, freshman Gretchen Krass will play Hope Langdon and sophomore Robert Beyer will appear as Geoffrey. Other cast members include junior Matt Maurer as Flint, sophomore Elizabeth Carroll as Lettie and senior Jason Seifert as Nigel Rancour.
