## **BOOK OF REVELATION EXHIBIT AT UD'S MARIAN LIBRARY**

DAYTON, Ohio -- "The Book of Revelation (Apocalypse)," a collection of works by Swiss painter and sculptor Anton Mutter, is on display through Thursday, April 30, in the University of Dayton's Marian Library lobby. The exhibit, which is free and open to the public, is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Mutter's paintings and sculptures blend religion and nature, especially the cycle of birth, growth, death, and rebirth that is suggested in nature. He expresses the unceasing combat between good and evil and the contrasts between time and eternity.

After studying the Apocalypse for more than 10 years, Mutter depicts the Book of Revelation which includes the events of salvation history. He has painted the Apocalypse in six tableaux which are graphically interconnected and simulate book form.
