CELEBRATION, UD VOCAL JAZZ GROUP, TO SHOW OFF "BRAND NEW ATTITUDE"

DAYTON, Ohio -- The University of Dayton's vocal jazz ensemble, Celebration, will display a "Brand New Attitude" in its final performance of the school year at 8 p.m., April 11, in the Boll Theatre on campus.

The show is free and open to the public.

Celebration's performance, which combines vocal performances with some theatrics, will include contemporary songs by Stevie Wonder and Michael Bolton, as well as 50s and 60s classics including "Misty," "Day By Day" and "Bridge Over Troubled Water."

The 15 Celebration members, under the direction of Donna Cox, a music professor at UD, perform regularly at the University and at conventions and shows around the state. Their singing and bright theatrical style also appeal to elderly audiences in area nursing homes where they perform frequently as a public service.
