**UD TO OFFER MASTER'S DEGREE IN CATHOLIC
SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION THIS SUMMER**

DAYTON, Ohio -- Catholic school educators who want to earn a master's degree in educational administration through the University of Dayton can attend two three-week class sessions this summer on campus.

The sessions will run from June 22 to July 10 and from July 13 to July 31. Six courses, each worth three or four credit hours, will be offered during each session.

Participants earn a master's degree in educational administration through UD by completing a total of 12 courses over three summers. The UD program is designed to prepare educators to work as effective Catholic school administrators, to help them meet state certification requirements and to accommodate their individual needs. Students new to the program are encouraged to contact Donald J. Frericks, assistant dean of UD's School of Education, in order to plan their sequence of study.
