UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON EXPECTS RECORD ENROLLMENT OF NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARS

DAYTON, Ohio -- The University of Dayton expects to enroll a record 22 National Merit scholars in the fall and continues to rank third nationally among Catholic colleges and universities in the number it has attracted in the past five years.

Since 1987, the University of Dayton has enrolled 66 National Merit scholars. Only the University of Notre Dame, with 171, and Georgetown University, with 129, have enrolled more, according to National Merit annual reports. There are 232 Catholic colleges and universities in the United States.

Among Ohio's 45 private colleges and universities, the University of Dayton ranks third behind Oberlin College and Case Western Reserve University in the same five-year period.
