ART EXHIBITION AT UD'S MARIAN LIBRARY

DAYTON, Ohio -- An exhibition of fabric sculpture by Margaret Hays will be on display in the lobby of the University of Dayton's Marian Library from March 8 to April 30.

Hays has received awards from the Pacific Northwest Needle Arts Guild in Seattle, Washington; the Edmonds Arts Festival in Edmonds, Washington; and the Mercer Island Visual Arts League in Mercer Island, Washington.

Hays will have sixteen works on display at UD. Among these works are fabric sculptures of madonnas and other religous icons. Admission to the exhibit is free and open to the public.

UD's Marian Library, the world's largest and most comprehensive collection of printed material on Mary, was established in 1943. It now holds more than 84,000 books and pamphlets in 50 languages, ranging from the 15th century to the present, as well as a collection of statues from around the world.
