APRIL 1: UD SORORITY PROMOTES SELF-EXAMS FOR BREAST CANCER

The University of Dayton chapter of Zeta Tau Alpha will join a nationwide effort on Thursday, April 1, to urge women to perform monthly self-examinations to detect breast cancer. College members and alumnae of the women's fraternity will be handing out free waterproof cards that can be hung in the shower. The cards illustrate how to perform a complete breast self-exam.

The national fraternity supports the work of the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation as its philanthropic project. One million cards will be handed out on April 1. The UD chapter, with 110 members, will hand out cards from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on campus, with a special focus on the Kennedy Union Plaza from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

APRIL 4: UD 'WORKOUT FOR HOPE' PROMOTES AIDS AWARENESS

A three-hour aerobics marathon, called a "Workout for Hope," will be held from 1 to 4 p.m. Sunday, April 4, in the Frericks Athletic Center at the University of Dayton. About 300 students and community members are expected to take part, along with eight aerobic instructors from the Dayton area and trainers and medical staff members from Miami Valley Hospital.

Money raised by pledges to participants will benefit AIDS research at the City of Hope National Medical Center. Dayton will be one of 80 sites participating nationwide.
