### **SUMMER ADVANCEMENT 1993 AT UD OFFERED TO HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS**

DAYTON, Ohio — High school juniors in the Dayton area who plan to attend college can take a free course at the University of Dayton this summer and earn credits toward a degree.

Applications for Summer Advancement 1993 are available through local high schools or by calling UD's admission office at (513) 229-4411 or (800) 837-7433. Deadline for application is May 15.

Selected applicants will enroll in regular summer courses taught by UD professors. Students can choose from more than 20 courses in subjects such as history, biology, mathematics, psychology, English and computer graphics. The program runs from June 21 through July 31.

Students pay no tuition but are responsible for textbook costs, lab fees and personal expenses. Enrollment is limited.
