**WORKSHOP TO BE HELD FOR COURT
ADMINISTRATORS AND CLERKS OF COURT**

DAYTON, Ohio — Court administrative staff and supervisors in clerk of court operations are invited to a workshop that will take a proactive approach to capias resolution and increasing fine collection.

The workshop will be held from 8:30 a.m - 4:15 p.m. March 2-3 at the Harley Hotel Cleveland South in Independence. Registration is \$270 and covers instruction and course materials, parking, lunch and refreshments.

University of Dayton communication associate professor Stephen J. Blatt and John Gilson, court operations manager for the City of Dayton Municipal Court, will teach participants how to improve court operations through enhanced communication and fine collection, reduce the number of unpaid fines and warrants, increase revenue of the courts, increase credibility of the court among elected officials and improve communication with court clientele.
