Note: On July 12, 1952, Mrs. Francis Goffin, year-round resident of Woods Hole, who lives next to the Rectory and across the street from the Tower and Garden, said that many of the original books of the Tower - a powerful attraction because of their calibre and, often, rarity - were destroyed or damaged by the 1938 hurricane, and that she and others salvaged what they could and sent them back to Mrs. Lillie in Chicago for rebinding.

In his 1946 article, "Lillie Tower", in the October, 1946 issue of OUR LADY'S DIGEST, reprinted from the August, 1946 issue of PERPETUAL HELP, Rev. James J. Galvin stated that in his visit to the Tower (1943), he found books (not there when the above cataloging was made) by Pascal, Abbot Columba Marmion, Hilaire Belloc, Chaucer, Dante, John of the Cross, Paul Claudel and Teresa of Avila.
