UD OFFERS NEW SUMMER
ACADEMIC PROGRAM

DAYTON, Ohio, March 16, 1983 -- The University of Dayton announces its Summer Advancement '83 Program for high school juniors. This new UD summer academic program enables students to earn credit free of charge, which can be applied toward their college major. Class will be held from June 20 through July 30, 1983.

The high school juniors will be enrolled in more than 30 regular college courses including subjects such as computer science, photography, theatre, psychology, and political science.

Summer Advancement '83 students pay no tuition and are only charged for textbooks and lab fees. For participants who eventually enroll in UD, the normal tuition charge is waived for course work taken in this program. Students who later attend other colleges and universities will be assessed tuition charges if a course credit transfer is requested.

Myron Achbach, UD director of admissions, believes "this new program is an excellent opportunity for high school juniors to get acquainted with college level course work.

Requirements for entry into this summer program include the completion of an application form and a letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor. Fifty area high school juniors will be chosen for Summer Advancement '83. Application deadline is May 15, 1983.
